1

1. No water bottles are permitted in the choir loft but are suggested during practices in the assembly room if you need water!
2. Classroom behavior is expected; being respectful, raising hands, staying in seats and not speaking out of turn. It is very hard to talk over many students, I don't want to ruin my voice and we have a lot of exciting things to get accomplished!
3. You are allowed to have **3 UNEXCUSED PRACTICES**. We want those students who are committed and want to be here. This is for fun but we **DO** want to make this something you can take pride in.

DEFINITION: EXCUSED PRACTICE

- a NOTE from a parent explaining your absence
- a call to Mrs. Rogers from your parent before the missed practice or an explanation following
- absent from school

**** We will need to contact your parents if you are absent in order to make sure you are safe!

Practices are held on Mondays and Thursdays from 3:00 – 4:00 PM. We may cancel some days to give you a rest if we get a lot accomplished at our other practices. Along with time off, we **WILL** have to extend practices or add additional dates for special activities, (especially in the Spring). We will give you advance notice in these cases so please be sure to share any “Updates” with your parents and parents remember to ask if there IS anything. (I have found that many students forget to communicate!)
