Peter Pence Collection Next Sunday, June 28th. The Peter's Pence Collection derives its name from ancient custom. In ninth-century England, King Alfred the Great collected money – "pence" or pennies – from landowners as financial support for the Pope. Today, the Peter's Pence Collection supports the Pope's charitable work by giving the Holy Father the means to provide essential assistance.

Paint and Pane Fund: Totals, so far: paint - \$48,739.71 windows - \$53,511.56, grand total - \$102,251.27. Goals: paint-\$51,000 windows-\$151,000, total \$202,000. We're gettin' there! **We started to install some windows. After Mass, you can go down the pony track to the school and view the new windows on the first floor in the main building.**
