### LENTEN REGULATIONS

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday (April 10<sup>th</sup>) are days of fast and abstinence. All other Fridays are days of abstinence only. The law of Abstinence applies to everyone 14 years old and up. Abstinence means no meat. The Law of Fasting pertains to all Catholics from 18 years of age to their 59<sup>th</sup> birthday. Fasting means one full meal a day or two lesser meals not to equal a full meal.

**Eucharistic Adoration:** Remember, Eucharistic Adoration is every Thursday from 4pm – 6pm.

**Lent:** During Lent, I am adding additional times for confessions: Monday through Friday, before the 8 o'clock Mass, 7:30am – 7:55am and after the 8 o'clock Mass, 8:25am – 8:50am.

**Stations of the Cross and Mass:** During Lent, Friday afternoons at 5 o'clock
