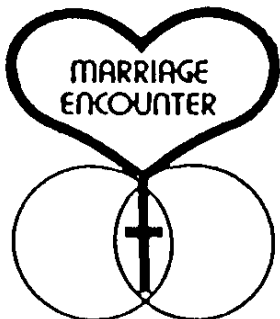

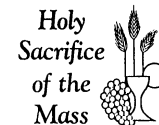
from the Pastor's Desk

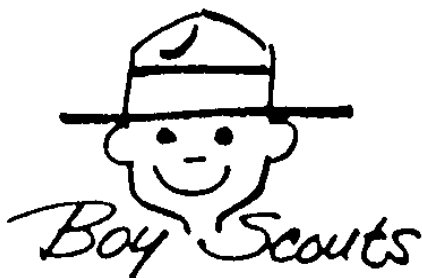
Pilgrim Virgin Statue: Please see today's insert about the Pilgrim Virgin Statue that will be here Thursday, November 4.

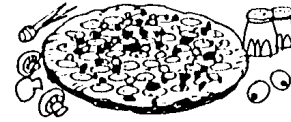
