Reminders from the School Office

*If your child will be absent from school you are required to call the school office at 921-4996 before 8:30 am. If there is no answer please press extension 35 and leave a message. You must call the office each day the child is not in school. Reason for absence notes should be sent to school on the first day your child returns to school. If requested, missed assignments will be available in the school office after school and may be sent home with a sibling. Students are required to make up all work they may have missed.

*If you are picking your child up early for an appointment please send a note with your child in the morning. It is important that we know when and by whom your child is being picked up. You must come to the office to meet your child and sign him or her out. Please try to make all appointments after school hours.

News from Ms. D-C, School Nurse

The state of Ohio requires certain immunizations of all students. **Parents of kindergarteners if you have not yet turned in your child's immunization (shot) record PLEASE TURN THEM INTO THE SCHOOL OFFICE AT ONCE**, if you have not already done so. If you receive a letter from the school nurse saying that certain shots are still needed, call your doctor for an updated shot record or take your student to your doctor or clinic to receive the needed immunization. If your student has not received the needed immunizations (or is not in the process) to receive them, he/she will not be able to attend school after October 6, 2011.
